RTOERO has a long history of giving back to its communities. The annual provision of grants to districts in support of projects in their communities, and scholarships for post-secondary students are sterling examples.

The Community Grants and Scholarships Committee, formerly known as Project – Service to Others (PSTO), is responsible for reviewing submissions from districts for grants and from students for scholarships and recommending both to the Board for its approval.

Community Grants are designed to encourage all districts to support and partner with local community organizations to promote projects that will help RTOERO meet our strategic goals of improving the lives of members and seniors; being the trusted voice for the broader education communities; and broadening our membership base. Since the inception of this grant, RTOERO has donated \$1.85 million for 523 projects.
